John Wisheart, New Road, presented the Committee with sample noise ordinances from other Townships and DEP that he would like the Committee to consider. The Mayor stated the Committee would like to help in any way they can. The documents presented would be discussed at a work session. However, in speaking with Tabernacle the problem there is no one to enforce the ordinance. Nor do they have a decimal reader or certified individual to operate the reader. We can have all the ordinances on the books but what good are they if we don't have the resources to enforce them.

Judy, 131 Main Street, thanked the Mayor for all his work with the sewer in the Village. She further stated her displeasure with public works employees not being able to accept gratuities from the public. The solicitor stated the State of New Jersey doesn't permit public employees to accept gifts. In addition she thanked the Mayor for the Christmas concert.

No one else from the public wishing to be heard the public portion was closed.

The Mayor stated on a sad note the Committee received a letter from Committeeman Laufer that due to health reasons he would be resigning from the Committee as of February 1, 2014.

The Mayor appointed Committeeman Heston as the liaison to work with former Deputy Mayor Moore and the Township Administrator and Finance Officer on the 2014 budget. Mr. Moore would receive \$500.00 for his services.

Committeewoman Rossell updated the public on the Southampton Business Association Meeting she attended on January 22, 2014. The Association meets at 6:30 PM at the Red Lion Inn.

Further update was provided on the Shade Tree meeting and the Environmental Committee meeting.

The consensus of the Township Committee is the Township is very fortunate to have the volunteers and committees we do.

Committeeman Tiver and Committeeman Heston thanked the public works department for their hard work during the snow storms.

Committeeman Heston stated a local paving company has offered to pave and stripe the new township building.


Mayor Young stated Southampton Township and Southampton Recreation Association (STRA) would partner together to work on Southampton Day in August.
