

## SOUTHAMPTON TOWNSHIP MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 3, 2014 AT 10:00 A.M.

The special meeting of the Southampton Township Committee was held on October 3, 2014 at the Robert L. Thompson Building, 5 Retreat Road, Southampton, New Jersey. The meeting was called to order by Mayor James Young at 10:00 AM and followed by a salute to the Flag of the United State of America.

5. Good Farm – Red Lion Road/Church Road
6. Ball Park – 458 Red Lion Road
7. Public Works Garage (new) – 1905 Route 206
8. Public Works Garage (old) – 16 Buddtown Road

Upon their return they discussed with Mr. Oatman the two (2) public works facilities and the needs of the department.


Mayor Young opened the meeting to the public.
