

James Cuttino, 15 Cotherstone Drive, requested the Committee grant an exception to the three (3) year road opening moratorium for the five (5) residents on Cotherstone who would like PSE&G to open the newly paved road for installation of gas lines for conversion from electric to gas.

Mayor Young explained the moratorium and the law on the books for the moratorium. The paving of Cotherstone was done with tax payer's money and the governing body has a responsibility. If the Committee makes an exception for you then they have to make an exception for everyone. What is the purpose of having the law on the books?

The Township Engineer, Frank Morris, stated a patch is just that a patch.

The 27 residents on Cotherstone who do not currently have gas were sent letters asking about if they would be interested in converting. Five responded they would and one resident called to say he wasn't interested and did not want the road opened and patched. Joe, 12 Cotherstone Drive, inquired about going through the grass on the properties and tunneling under the road and tying into the main on corner Westminster Drive. Mayor Young stated the Administrator and Engineer would contact PSE&G and see if this could be done.

George Morris, Esq., asked the Mayor to poll the Committee on granting an exception.

NAYES: Committeeman Heston, Committeeman Raftery, Committeewoman Rossell, Deputy Mayor Tiver and Mayor Young. Mayor Young stated if you do for one you have to do for all.

Pat Topham, New Road, thanked Committeeman Heston for stating the ordinances need to be reviewed and updated. Previously she was before the Committee and gave examples of other township's noise ordinances and requested the Committee review the Township's current noise ordinance.

Steve Bowker, Main Street, discussed and inquired about the Vincent EMS and the building and the Township's interest in the building.


