

**SOUTHAMPTON TOWNSHIP WORK SESSION MEETING
MINUTES
JUNE 28, 2016 AT 7:00 P.M.**

The special meeting of the Southampton Township Committee was held on June 28, 2016 at the Robert L. Thompson Building, 5 Retreat Road, Southampton, New Jersey. The meeting was called to order by Mayor James Young at 7:00 PM and followed by a salute to the Flag of the United State of America.

A roll call confirmed those Committee members who were present, which included Deputy Mayor Ronald Heston, Committeeman Bill Raftery, Committeewoman Elizabeth Rossell, Committeeman Mike Mikulski, and Mayor James F. Young, Sr.

EMS Services

Tom Heller and Chuck McSweeney were unable to attend the meeting. Kit Applegate, Esquire attorney for the Hampton Lakes Emergency Squad was present. He stated he was unable to provide an update or discuss the financials for the squad. However, he was able to provide the Committee with an update on the revisions to the prior contract and current contract the Township and Squad are operating under based upon the current proposal response the Township received and awarded to the Squad. He further updated the Committee on the changes transpiring and being worked on. He believes the changes will be in place within the next three (3) months and the Township will be pleased. Together the department is working on making the organization more professional and less like a social club.

The Committee discussed and asked questions about billing the Township residents and outside Townships whom the squad responds to on calls. The Committee asked additional various questions in reference to billing, Medicare and refusal of service definitions.

Mr. Applegate and the Township Committee agreed another update and continued dialogue on the Squad would be given in three (3) months.

Mayor Young presented his recommendations to the other Committee members on liaisons and sub-committees for the Township.

Mayor Young opened the meeting to the public for comment. No one from the public wishing to be heard the public portion was closed.


No formal action was taken.
